Therefore, we invite you to partake of the Lord's Supper provided that you indicate to us that you are able to make the following affirmations by signing this form and handing it to an usher when the offering is collected. Thank you! - The Elders of College Hill Reformed Church

1. There is only one true God, the Creator and Ruler of the universe, who eternally exists in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
2. The Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are the inspired word of God, the only perfect standard for faith and conduct.
3. There is no salvation apart from Jesus Christ, the Son of God. He became human to die for sinners. God raised Jesus from death for our salvation, and enthroned him in heaven as Lord. He will return to judge the world. We are saved through faith alone, by grace alone, in Christ alone.
4. I repent of my sin; I trust Jesus Christ as my Savior, and I am committed to obeying and serving Him as my Lord.
5. I have been baptized in a church that upholds the doctrine of the Trinity (described in affirmation #1).
6. I have made a public profession of faith, and am under the oversight of an evangelical Christian Church (An evangelical Christian church is one that affirms the first three statements above. This excludes Roman Catholic and Eastern Orthodox churches.)
