## THE LORD'S SUPPER

Dear Visitor...

On August 2<sup>nd</sup>, we are planning to celebrate the Lord's Supper. We do not wish to exclude from the Lord's Table our Christian brothers and sisters from other churches who are worshiping with us. But we also want to be careful in how we administer this holy meal. As you anticipate this celebration, we will invite you to the table provided that you are able to affirm the six statements below. If you are able to affirm all six, we would ask that you take the opportunity to meet with the elders after the service either today (7/19), or next week (7/26), in the Cypress Room at the front of the auditorium, so that we can formally welcome you to the table. Thank you!

1. There is only one true God, the Creator and Ruler of the universe, who eternally exists in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
2. The Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are the inspired word of God, the only perfect standard for faith and conduct.
3. There is no salvation apart from Jesus Christ, the Son of God. He became human to die for sinners. God raised Jesus from death for our salvation, and enthroned him in heaven as Lord. He will return to judge the world. We are saved through faith alone, by grace alone, in Christ alone.
4. I repent of my sin; I trust Jesus Christ as my Savior, and I am committed to obeying and serving Him as my Lord.
5. I have been baptized in a church that upholds the doctrine of the Trinity (described in affirmation #1).
6. I have made a public profession of faith, and am under the oversight of an evangelical Christian Church (An evangelical Christian church is one that affirms the first three statements above. This excludes Roman Catholic and Eastern Orthodox churches)
